Canadian Association for Biological Anthropology (CABA) – l'Association canadienne d'anthropologie biologique (ACAB) 2023 Logo Competition Rules and Regulations

APPLICANT

- Applicants can be of any education level and career stage (i.e. the competition is open to everyone; not just students*).
- Applicants do not need to be CABA-ACAB members.
- *Only CABA-ACAB student or special members are eligible for free membership for a year. If a different category of CABA-ACAB member (e.g., regular, life) wins the competition they may chose to donate the free membership to a student or special member of their choice. Non CABA-ACAB members are not eligible to receive or donate the free membership.

SUBMISSION

- Logos must contain the acronyms "CABA" and "ACAB". They do not need to include the full name of the Association.
- Applicants may submit a maximum of two different logos.
- The winning logo must be available as png and tif files. It must have a minimum size of 10" and dpi of 600.
- A black and white version of the logo is required. A colour version of the logo is optional.
- Logos should be inclusive of all subfields of Biological Anthropology. Our members do diverse research so it may be difficult to represent all subfields if the logo includes stylized images or icons. Thus, purely text-based logos are welcome. Do not feel it is necessary that the logo include any sort of image.
- Submissions can be made through the CABA-ACAB website. See the website (caba-acab.net) for instructions.

JUDGING

- The executive will be the initial judges about the suitability of a submission. The executive reserves the right to not choose any logo for member-wide voting if none are deemed suitable.
- Submissions that are deemed suitable will be voted on electronically by all CABA-ACAB members. The winning submission will be chosen by majority vote. To vote, one must be a current CABA-ACAB member in good standing.

PRIZE

- The winning applicant will be awarded \$300 Canadian dollars.
- As noted above, only CABA-ACAB student or special members can receive the free membership for a year. If an individual with a different membership type (e.g., regular, life) wins the competition they can transfer the free membership to a student or special member of their choice.

TIMELINE

- Competition launch: May 15th 2023

- Submission deadline: August 1st 2023

- Winning submission announcement: Sept 1st 2023
