

ANTH 4701 Internship in Forensic Anthropology May 3-17, 2014 Miami, Florida

This is a practical, hands-on course in forensic anthropology utilizing forensic skeletal remains from the Miami-Dade County Medical Examiner Department. It will provide a multi-disciplinary approach to the field of forensic anthropology. The course is two weeks long and will include the examination and identification of human remains, writing forensic anthropology reports, learning maceration techniques of bodies in various stages of decomposition, observing autopsies, forensic odontology/bitemark lectures and analyses, toxicology and DNA analyses, forensic photography workshop, and discussions about Death Investigation with the case investigators.
